

Yes, Canva pages can be embedded into web pages by using the embed feature that Canva provides. To do this, you can:

Open your Canva design.

Click the Share button.

Select Embed from the options.

Copy the provided HTML embed code or smart embed link.

Paste that embed code into your website's HTML where you want the Canva page to appear.

This allows you to embed either entire Canva designs or single pages from a design as interactive content on your website. Updates you make to the Canva design will automatically reflect on the embedded version on your site. This method works well on platforms that support HTML embed codes and oEmbed, such as WordPress or Medium.

Additionally, Canva websites are multi-page and when published, each page appears as a separate scrollable page. So you can create multi-page Canva websites with linked pages within Canva, then embed them or publish the website directly.

Note: Some users have reported difficulty embedding Canva "webpages" directly on platforms like Squarespace, indicating that embedding may be limited to Canva designs and documents rather than full Canva websites.

In summary, you can add Canva pages to your web pages by embedding Canva designs using their embed feature, which generates HTML code to integrate on your site. This is the supported and most straightforward method.
